The total donations to Cystic Fibrosis Canada for the 2017/2018 year were \$1,256,695. Fantastic work!!

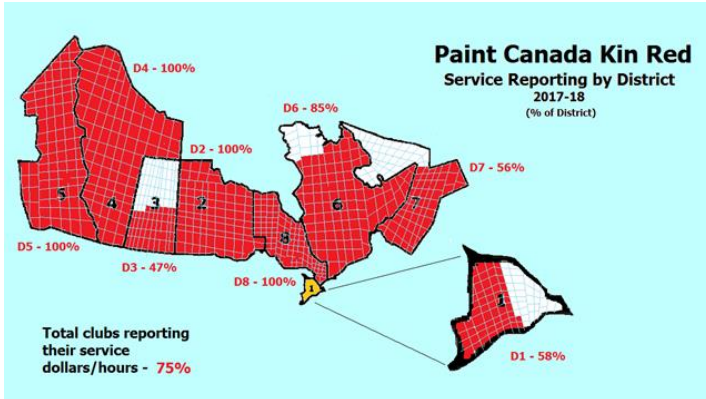


National Day of KINDness
