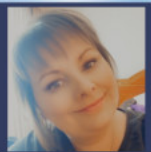

I KNOW RISK MANAGEMENT IS NOT EVERYONE'S FAVORITE THING TO TALK ABOUT BUT I DO HAVE 4 THINGS TO DISCUSS WITH ALL OF YOU:
1) CLUB REQUIREMENTS, 2) NATIONAL DUES,
3) INSURANCE & 4) INCORPORATIONS.



CLUB REQUIREMENTS

We are far past our November 15th deadline for completion of club requirements and therefore, National will be sending out letters of Not In Good Standing to any clubs who have outstanding items. Please reach out to me if your club needs assistance in completing any of these items. There are restrictions to club activities for club's with a status of "Not In Good Standing". *As a reminder, your club must be in good standing in order to attend TeleMiracle!* No member of any of the district teams wants to restrict you from attending one the best events of the year, so lets get those requirements completed!

NATIONAL DUES

Make sure your rosters are up to date by January 31st, 2023 as these numbers are what will be used for the 2nd billing of National dues which come out in February 2023.

INCORPORATIONS

Make sure to have your incorporations complete and your club members up to date on the incorporations. This is one of our club requirements for National and also a requirement for our insurance. There are three notable benefits for being incorporated...1) A not-for-profit may engage in activities that produce a "profit" for the club, 2) Generally exempts the club from paying income tax, and 3) Protects each's member's personal assets in the event of a lawsuit or bankruptcy by making the club a separate legal entity.

INSURANCE

Make sure that your club is applying for the certificate of insurance for EVERY project that your club does. If you don't request the certificate then you run the risk of your project not being covered under the national insurance policy. This can put yourself and your members at risk. You do not want to personally be affected by any legal costs should an incident occur. Even though clubs are incorporated, and your personal assets would be protected there is no guarantee that legal costs would not be incurred to you personally if your club's project is not covered under the national insurance policy. Reach out to me if you have any questions! I will also be sending out more information on this in the near future.

Club Support Report

Happy New Year D3,

As we pass the midway point in the Kin year, it may be helpful to send out the Club Health Assessment to your members.

The Club Health Assessment is a great tool to use, no matter the time of year. Whether you have been active in the pandemic or have been struggling to get out, it's important to know if your membership is comfortable with how the club is running. Little things can easily become big things if you aren't proactive in addressing minor issues.

There are many ways of doing a Club Health Assessment. There is an online fillable form that will be sent to myself, this can be completely anonymous if you would like. There is also a fillable PDF that can be emailed out to your club, this can also be filled in anonymously, then emailed to anyone of your choice: district executive, club executive or an unbiased non-member. This form can also be printed out to be filled out during a meeting then submitted to the club electives.

Any and all ways of proceeding with a Club Health Assessment is a great way to have an open and honest dialogue about potential club issues, as well as being a great member check-in even if no concerns are voiced. It is a great way to track your club's strengths and weaknesses in order to keep a happy, healthy membership.

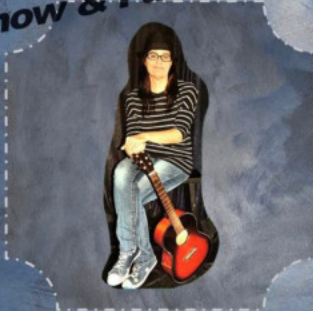

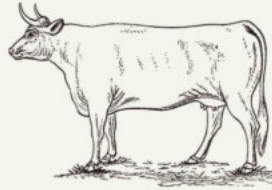
