



### **Kin CommUnity Award**

**Timeline:** Ongoing

**Purpose:** This award is to recognize Kin clubs that have an incredible working relationship with other clubs/community groups. It could be two or more Kin clubs working together on a project, or a Kin club partnering with a non-Kin group on a community event. Whatever the scenario, Kin clubs working together with other groups (Kin or non-Kin) build connections within their community. They may not always see eye to eye but have an understanding and know how to make their relationships work. These clubs are great ambassadors of Kin and should be recognized!

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

1. A joint fundraiser or project is required to win this award. The fundraiser or project **MUST** be completed within 12 months prior to applying for this award.

**NOTE:** Clubs or groups do not necessarily have to be in the same city or town.

2. All clubs listed in application **MUST** be in good standing.
3. This award can be won multiple times by the same club.
4. Award is granted at the discretion of the District Awards Committee.
